

NARC CHAIR REPORT IOHA BOARD MEETING, October, 2024

National Accreditation Recognition Committee

Date report: 10 October 2024



1. INTRODUCTION

The NARC has worked well in 2024 and accomplished a significant number of achievements which will be discussed in this Report.

Committee Mission Statement

To promote global respect for and recognition of occupational hygiene credentialing programs conducted by national associations and organisations which meet or exceed the requirements in the National Accreditation Recognition Program.

Purpose and Activities

To promote the mission by:


- Receiving and reviewing applications from Occupational Hygiene Certification Boards seeking IOHA Recognition.
- Maintain the NARC procedures to ensure they reflect the current operating framework for the
 profession and where appropriate, recommend changes for approval by the IOHA Board. The
 key documents for review are the National Accreditation Recognition Program procedure and
 the NARC Matrix Assessment Tool.
- Establish communications with prospective national associations with an emphasis on promoting their certification programs for recognition by the NAR.
- Develop a consulting role and support network which assists countries in their ability to achieve IOHA recognized.
- Maintain the NARC Register listing the national associations and organizations with recognized programs and numbers of certified occupational hygienists globally.

2. CERTIFIED OH/IH MEMBERS

The NARC has established a Register where all NARC members report in June the numbers of active and retired certified occupational hygienists.

In June 2024, there are 8353 active certified occupational hygienists globally, excluding retired certified members. The number continues to grow with the US BGC having the highest number of CIHs with 6886 members.

It is interesting to note that the next three national associations with >200 COH/CIH are from countries with a large regulated mining, oil and gas sector.

4. NEW NAR COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

The new NARC structure comprising of Chair, Deputy Chair and Immediate Past Chair has worked well in 2024. The Chairperson is in the role for 1 year. The new structure has ensured that there is support for the Chair such as coverage if the Chair is not available for the meeting, the Deputy or Past Chair have also participated with the Chair in zoom meetings with new potential national associations. The Deputy Chair now supports the Chair and the Committee by preparing the Minutes.

5. NEW APPLICATIONS, RE-ACCREDITATIONS AND MENTORSHIP

Re-Accreditations

Each accredited national association is re-accredited on a 5-yearly cycle. The following re-assessments were successfully completed in 2024. The year of their first accreditation has been included:

- Southern African Institute of Occupational Hygiene (SAIOH), 2006
- German Society for Occupational Hygiene (DGAH), 2014
- Swiss Society of Occupational Hygiene (SSOH), 2009
- Board for Global EHS Credentialling (BGC), 2003

Changes made by the Dutch government which previously registered occupational hygienists has resulted in Dutch Occupational Hygiene Society (NVvA) developing their own in-house assessment procedure. The NARC is supporting the NVvA Board through this process have provided extensions until 31 December 2024

New Assessments and New Candidates

There were no new assessments in 2024. However, there are five national associations in the pipeline preparing their documentation for NAR accreditation assessment. Zoom meetings as well as email communications have continued with representatives from:

- Argentina Society of Occupational Hygiene (SAHIO)
- Indonesian Industrial Hygiene Association (IIHS)
- Mongolian National Association of Industrial Hygiene (MNAOH) and
- Turkiye Industrial Toxicology and Occupational Hygiene Association, (ETOK IHDER)

Mentorship

Mr. Haruo Hashimoto, (JAWE) has been mentoring the Indonesian Industrial Hygiene Association (IIHA) to develop their credentialling program. IIHA have been organizing their Board and certification procedures with their first exams planned for in 1Q25. The Committee is most grateful to Haruo Hashimoto for his mentorship to this organization.

6. NAR CHIEF REVIEWER

In 2023, the IOHA ExCo agreed to establish the new position of NAR Chief Reviewer reporting to the NARC Chair. The Chief Reviewer will be responsible for conducting thorough and unbiased reviews for the NARC with new and re-assessment applications. The position was advertised and the successful applicant was Dr Sharann Johnson AM, the Current NARC Chair.

The NARC Matrix Assessment Tool was reviewed and significant changes were made to improve the criteria and also reflect changes which were happening in the national associations.

- Criteria 1 Certification Board, with a greater focus and assessment of responsibilities and management of the examinations.
- Criteria 2 Code of Ethics with the focus on implementation and training awareness.
- Criteria 3 Education and Training, changes were made to reflect the changing nature of education
 and experience of occupational hygienists registering to sit for the certification examination. There are
 now 2 pathways which the national association can select from, depending on the education available
 in the country.
- Criteria 4 Examination Process has also been updated to reflect current practices of professional competence of candidate is determined using a written examination or an oral exam or a combination of both.
- Criteria 5 Evaluation of the Examination Results, this criteria focusses on more transparency and consistent evaluation.
- Criteria 6 Certification of Maintenance Process, now provides more detail guidance.

8. IOHA WEBSITE

In 2024, improvements were made to the NARC section of the IOHA website to increase transparency and information about the certification programs in the various member countries.
